

2020 Fall Art Classes & Workshops Health & Safety Information

The Attleboro Arts Museum has been carefully planning a safe approach for your <u>IN-PERSON</u> fall session. Autumn at the Museum will look and feel different than previous years, and each of us will play a role in ensuring the collective health and safety of our AAM community.

We ask that caretakers of minors (17 years and under) review all health and safety requirements with their child in advance of the first day of class.

<u>1 — Virtual Signature Page – FOR ALL ART STUDENTS:</u>

We require the completion of this form prior to the start of each art session at the Museum. We've switched to virtual for hands free collection – a link to this online form will be included in your confirmation email, and must be completed <u>prior</u> to the start of your/your child's art class or workshop*:

*If you've registered more than one child for our fall session, please submit a signature page for each child. Click on "submit another response" at the end of the online form to complete another signature page.

2 — HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ART STUDENTS:

- *Cover Up Creatives* Please wear a face mask or face covering to art class. Coverings must be properly worn throughout a visit to the Museum.
- Art is Messy Please wear your own art smock or t-shirt (an over the head tee or Velcro non-tying smock is preferred for ages 5-8).
- Bring Your Own Art Materials Unless otherwise indicated, students will be providing their own art materials. Please refer to each individual art class or workshop for specifics and prerequisites. Students will not be sharing art supplies and only touching their own personal supplies, tools & belongings. Students will be required to keep all of their belongings at their designated space/seat in the studio.

The Museum is following CDC and state mandated guidelines by:

- Limiting the number of students in each in-person art class or workshop
- Social distancing by rearranging classrooms to ensure six feet between students, faculty, and staff.
- Installing public health signage and messaging in all areas of the Museum to continually reinforce community expectations (social distancing, hand washing, face masks, etc.)
- Providing hand sanitizing stations in the lobby, gallery and art studios. All hand sanitizer dispensers, soap and paper towels will be refilled frequently.

• Staff will sanitize *high touch point surfaces* several times a day and the Museum's professional cleaning firm will sanitize all *high touch* surfaces on a weekly basis.

<u>3 — IN-PERSON ART CLASSES & WORKSHOPS PROCEDURES:</u>

Adult Students (18+) – Arrival at the Attleboro Arts Museum:

- Arrival time for art sessions is no earlier than **10 minutes** before the scheduled start time.
- Please park your vehicle in the Museum's lot and enter through our Emory Street main entrance.
- Please be ready to enter the Museum with your face mask or face covering on and have your art smock & art materials with you.
- You will be asked for your name and which art class or workshop you're attending.
- We will then take your temperature with a "no touch thermometer." If any student has a temperature above 100.3 degrees, they will be asked to leave and contact their doctor.

Minor Students (17 years and under) – Curbside Drop-off & Pickup:

To allow for social distancing and health & safety procedures, we will be coordinating curbside drop-off and pickup of all minor art students.

When you arrive at the Museum for Drop-off:

- Arrival time for art sessions is no earlier than **10 minutes** before the scheduled start time.
- Please drive to the Museum's parking lot and use the Morey Street lot entrance. Please only enter the lot using Morey Street the lot will be one-way for easy in and out. You will see a staff member waiting for you with a wave!
- Before your child exits your vehicle:
 - You will be asked for your child's name and who will be picking them up that day. *All pre-authorized pickup individuals will be required to present an ID.*
 - We will then take your child's temperature with a "no touch thermometer" through the vehicle window. If any student has a temperature above 100.3 degrees, they will be asked to leave and contact their doctor.
 - Please have your child ready to enter with their mask & smock on and art supplies in a backpack or tote bag.
- If the above steps are completed successfully, your child will be escorted by a staff member or intern to their art studio. *If your child needs to wait for a staff member or intern, we will ask them to stand on social distancing floor markers in our lobby (laid out 6ft apart).*

When you arrive at the Museum for Pickup:

- Please enter the parking lot as you did for drop-off, using the Morey Street entrance the lot will be one-way for easy in and out. You will see a staff member waiting for you with a wave!
- You will be asked for the child's name you're picking up. *All pre-authorized pickup individuals will need to present an ID.*
- Once pickup is confirmed, we will send your child out to you.
