

















Feel the Rhythm with Sumi Ink – A Sketchbook Play Workshop

Supply List:

<p>1 – Assorted brushes for sumi ink and watercolors. Sumi Brush #2 and # 6 or equivalent</p>	
<p>2 – Sumi Ink “Black” smallest bottle</p>	
<p>3 – Speedball calligraphy Ink “Scarlet Red” smallest bottle. <i>If you don’t like red you can choose another color. Choose a color that will contrast with black sumi ink.</i> <i>*Optional: Bring additional colors if you prefer</i></p>	
<p>4 – Daler-Rowney FW Acrylic Water-Resistant Artists’ Ink (in a color of your choice) or equivalent. Choose a color that will contrast with black sumi ink.</p>	
<p>5 – Watercolors (example: ultramarine blue, burnt sienna plus any red or orange). <i>*Optional: Bring additional colors if you prefer</i></p>	
<p>6 – Canson Mixed Media Paper Pad, 98lb, 7” x 10” or 9” x 12”</p>	
<p>7 – Pick one white media (any brand). Smallest size.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Either a white acrylic paint • or white gesso (Preferred) • or white gouache 	
<p>8 – Assortment of pencils and pens in black (black ink - waterproof). Sharpies work well. (Pens + pencils that can make thick, medium to wide lines)</p>	
<p>9 – White gel pen. Recommended brand: Uni-ball Signo UM-153 White Gel Pen</p>	
<p>10 – Little container for Sumi ink and water containers for washing brushes</p>	
<p>11 – Plastic 6-7 well palette.</p>	
<p>12 – Paper towels</p>	
<p>13 – A couple of small twigs/branches</p>	

14 – Printer paper (10- 20 sheets)	
15 – Stainless Steel metal scrubber	
16 – Plastic fork	
17 – Artist tape, ½” wide	
<p>Optional Supplies Below: <i>For making some nature and upcycled pens for expanded variety and a gold pigment for metallic embellishments</i></p>	
*Schmincke Aqua Bronze - Rich Gold, 20 ml	
Old credit card or mat board	
Glue or hot glue for making the pens	
Grey paper palette any size (OR alternatively, use wax paper and tape to create an alternative palette)	
Chopstick, bamboo skewer
