Dotting Tools:

- No. 2 pencil eraser (unused)
- Jumbo pencil eraser (unused)
- · Cotton swab with one end removed
- End of a paint brush
- Several cotton swabs for correcting mistakes
- Damp paper towel or cloth to clean dotting tools
