- 1 Kneaded eraser
- 1 Gum eraser
- 1 Paper stump (blending stick) larger size
- 1 Box of vine charcoal soft
- 2 Sticks of compressed charcoal or a small box (medium or hard)
- 1 Charcoal pencil (black)
- 1 Stick of white charcoal or white charcoal pencil
- 1 Pair of scissors
- 1 X-Acto knife or 1 Pencil sharpener
- 1 roll of masking tape
- 1 Small jar of waterproof India ink (Black or brown)
- 1 Ink wash brush (Round Sumi) or (Bamboo Round Brush) large
- 1 small water color brush
- 1 Chamois clothe
- Elmers glue or Liquitex® Matte Medium
- 1 small piece of thin cardboard (make a view finder)
- 1 Large recycled plastic container jar (for ink wash water)
- 1 Can of workable fixative spray or permanent fixative spray
- Bag of Recycled found materials. Examples: old newspapers, magazines, ticket stubs, wine labels, tin can labels, scrap papers, wallpaper samples, color paint samples, old maps, old books, postcards, cards, letters, old photos, gift wrap, tissue paper, fabric scraps, ribbons, buttons, strings, thread, twine, yarn, glitter, metallic papers, semi-transparent paper, tracing papers, colored tapes, duct tape, old envelopes and stationery, junk mail, stamps, index cards, graph paper, pressed flowers, leaves ...
