

Watercolors: Materials List

Supply List:

- Medium or large palette with cover
 - Drawing pencil
 - Kneaded eraser
 - Plastic container for water
 - Paper towels
 - Light drawing board to support watercolor paper (12" x 18" or 18" x 24")
 - 1" roll of masking tape
 - Piece of natural sea sponge
 - Single-edged razor blade
 - Spray bottle
 - At least a 9" x 12" or larger Wet Media Sketch Pad
 - Your own collection of photographs for reference.
-
- **Watercolor Paper:**
 - 140lb weight (cold press – student grade with cotton).
 - Full sheet is 20" x 30,"students can tare a full sheet into quarters (10" x 15" sheets)
-
- **Paint Colors**
(Recommended brands are Van Gogh, Cotman or Academy – student grade):
 - Gamboge Yellow, Raw Sienna, Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red (Deep Hue), Pthalo Blue, Ultra Marine Blue, Sepia.
 - OPTIONAL Additional Colors: Raw Umber, Lemon Yellow, Burnt Sienna, Sap Green.
-
- **Brushes**
(Be sure to select brushes that are for watercolors – can be hair, synthetic or a mix):
 - 1" Flat Brush
 - #10 or #12 Round Brush
 - #4 Rigger Brush
