

Painting with Color Materials List Instructor: Susan Bauer

Supplies:

- Acrylic paint heavy body*:
 - o Titanium white 5 oz
 - o Cadmium yellow light or lemon yellow 2 oz
 - o Cadmium yellow medium or cadmium yellow deep 2 oz
 - o Cadmium red light 2 oz
 - Alizarin red 2 oz
 - Cerulean blue 2 oz
 - Ultramarine blue 2 oz
 - Yellow ochre 2 oz
 - o Burnt sienna 2 oz

*Instructor suggests buying good quality paint, the tinting properties are much better and coverage is better. Some recommended brands are Golden, Utrecht, M. Graham, Windsor Newton. Liquitex is ok but not as good.

- Various size acrylic bristle brushes; #2 or #3 filberts, #4 or #5 rounds and #8 or #10 flats. I find that filberts are the most versatile.
- Palette knife
- Paper palette (comes in pad) 18"x24" or a covered palette with sponge insert
- Paper towels
- 1 piece of watercolor paper 18x24
- Painting surface: Canvas board; aprox.11"x14" or canvas paper (comes in pad)
- Small sketch pad
- Drawing pencil/soft, Ebony is good
- Kneaded eraser
