

## Painting with Color Materials List

Instructor: Susan Bauer

### Supplies:

- Acrylic paint heavy body or oil paint:
  - Titanium white 5 oz
  - Cadmium yellow light or lemon yellow 2 oz
  - Cadmium yellow medium or cadmium yellow deep 2 oz
  - Cadmium red light 2 oz
  - Alizarin red 2 oz
  - Cerulean blue 2 oz
  - Ultramarine blue 2 oz

Additional colors (not required):

- Viridian 2 oz
- Yellow ochre 2 oz
- Burnt sienna 2 oz

*Instructor suggests buying good quality paint, the tinting properties are much better and coverage is better. Instructor recommends for acrylic paint Golden, Utrecht, M. Graham, Windsor Newton. Liquitex is ok, but not as good. For oil paint Utrecht is good for beginners.*

- Various size brushes; filberts, rounds and flats, have a small, medium and large selection. Of note: filberts are the most versatile.
- Palette knife
- Paper palette (comes in pad) 18"x24" or a covered palette with sponge insert for acrylic paint.
- Gamsol or other odorless mineral spirit for oil paint.
- Paper towels
- 2 sheets watercolor paper 18x24
- Canvas board or canvas paper, small sized, 11"x14" or smaller
- Small sketch pad
- Drawing pencil/soft
- Kneaded eraser
