### Supplies:

- Strathmore 400 Series Drawing Pad, 24 Sheets 14" x 17" or larger

- HB Graphite Pencil
- Sharpie Chisel Tip, Black

- 1 Kneaded eraser
- 1 Paper stump (blending stick) - larger size
- 1 Charcoal pencil (black)
- 1 White charcoal pencil

- 1 Roll of masking tape
- White Elmer's glue
- 2 Old manila folders

- Cheap old brush for applying glue.
- 1 small piece of thin cardboard (to make a view finder, cereal boxes are perfect for this)

*Do not purchase any collage materials – find or gather them.* Collage materials examples: Tulle; Buttons; Yarn; Raffia; Jute; Ribbons; Lace; Gauze; Fake fur; Felt; Feathers; Leaves; Any kind of paper – handmade, colored, etc.; Old photocopies; Old magazines; Old newspapers; Old small books; Paper bags, any size; Paper napkin; Paper doilies collage; Tissue paper; Crepe paper; Sandpaper; Corrugated cardboard & old cereal boxes; Old wallpaper books collage/printmaking.
